RE: New York Workers Compensation
Elimination of Hard Copy Policy Data Submissions - Reminder
Effective July 1, 2009

On December 18, 2007, the New York Compensation Insurance Rating Board issued a bulletin announcing a final submission date for hard copy policy data. It was stated in the Bulletin 2153, that hard copy submissions would no longer be accepted by NYCIRB beginning July 1, 2009. This bulletin is a reminder of that announcement and reaffirms the date this process will no longer be acceptable.

As also stated in R.C. 2153, data providers who report policy data on hard copy are encouraged to contact Ms. Lennora Snipes at lsnipes@nycirb.org, or (212) 697-3535 ext. 186, to learn more about their options for reporting this data. It is suggested, to those carriers who are unable to provide an electronic feed directly, to use PEEP (Policy Entry & Edit Package) or the secure file transfer facility CDX (Compensation Data Exchange) which is offered free to our members. Information about these products is also available online at www.accet.org.

Subsequent to July 1, 2009, we will return to the carrier any hard copy policies, endorsements, cancellations, or reinstatements which the Board receives. Please advise us if there are any remaining issues or concerns relating to this cutoff date.

Once again, your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
